FERTILIZATION AND WEED CONTROL-Cool Season

GreenWorx is committed to lush green, weed free lawns. Below is our approach to meeting this goal. We recommend all the services listed below. There are some additional services we consider one time turf care services but are not listed here as they are not needed annually.

Fertilization applications are numbered and weed control applications are lettered

Round 1 (Feb) – The first round of fertilization applies ½ pound of nitrogen to the soil to ready the turf for its most active growing season. This application also has a pre-emergent to help keep summer annual weeds like crab grass under control. If winter annual weeds are observed in the surf at this time, a post-emergent is applied. Some weeds will need a second application to be controlled.

Round 2 (Late March) – The second round of fertilization applies ½ pound of nitrogen to the soil to continue feeding the turf through the rest of the spring. This application also has a pre-emergent to extend the weed control for summer annual weeds like crab grass. If any winter annual weeds are observed in the turf at this time, a post-emergent is applied.

Rounds 1 & 2 are meant to control summer annual weeds and give the lawn a total of one pound of nitrogen for spring growth. Perennial weeds (Clover/Dandelion) are not controlled with a pre-emergent. No fertilizer should be applied after April 15th until fall.

Round A (May) – An inspection of turf health and a post emergent application is made to control perennial weeds like clover and dandelion. Some weeds may need a second application to be eradicated. Preventative Fungicide applications can be made at this time for an additional fee.

Round B (June) – An inspection of turf health and a post emergent application is made to control perennial weeds (Clover/Dandelion). Irrigation control is evaluated for summer months. Fungicide applications can be made at this time if needed for an additional fee.

Round C (Aug) – An inspection of turf health. Evaluate preparation needs for fall seeding. Apply post emergent weed control if needed.

Round 3 (Sept) – This application will give a boost of nitrogen and phosphorus (phosphorus may not be needed) to help bring lawns out of dormancy. This application also ensures plenty of nutrients available for seedlings. Weed control is suspended until seedlings have matured.

Round 4-D (Nov-Dec) – A ½ pound application of nitrogen will keep levels consistent through the growing season. Winter weeds are also controlled at this round with a post emergent application.

Soil tests should be taken every 2 - 4 years to ensure proper nutrient levels are applied to the turf. Soil tests also give pH readings and give lime recommendations. Soil samples are \$65 for the first sample and \$15 for additional samples.
